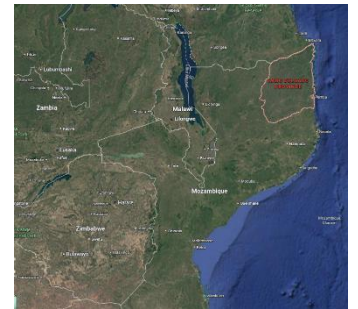
Churches continue to use the courses we offer at Emmanuel Press to educate congregations and support evangelism.

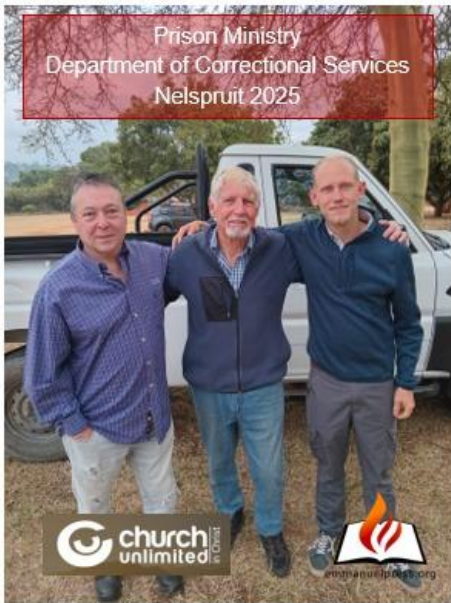

The photo below is a student certificate parade held in a small church in the far northern province of Cabo Delgado. The small village of Naminaue is in the district of Mieze. This is an area that has recently suffered under the scourge of terrorist attacks that are religiously motivated.



Calvin Khoza and I had opportunity to visit a local church in Hazyview. We had been invited by a young believer Devison Mokoena to encourage his youth group members. This group of young believers serve the Nazarene Revival Church and attend Gezingqondo Secondary School. This school is part of the ministry circuit that Calvin Khoza serves weekly.





You will all be happy to hear that a team of men from Church Unlimited in White River have successfully presented the first 2 lessons of the Basic Discipleship Course to the inmates of the Nelspruit Correctional Services Unit. The men in the photo are from the left Philip Sharpe, Robin Read and Ian Van Der Walt. The team is larger than just those three and we have 12 men with intention to play a role in presenting the course over the next three months. We have a number of men in our group that come with years of Holy Spirit guided experience to comfort and guide us. Unfortunately, I have not been able to secure any photos of the venue as cell phones are not allowed in. We are very encouraged by the cooperation offered up by the management of the Corrections Services Department.

The response to the course has overwhelmed our initial estimates and we are making changes to our strategy constantly. We trust that in the months ahead it will all settle down as relationships are built and confidence grows. The course material is such a blessing to the team as they navigate foreign territory.

Posters are being used to keep reminding the men about content that has been shared with them in the past week. The unit is not a stable setting in that it handles a large volume of awaiting trial inmates who then are either released or transferred.

My hope is that as we explore this model of ministry we will grow in confidence and Emmanuel Press will be able to assist other congregations in adopting a corrections unit and make a difference in the lives of these vulnerable men. Your prayers in this regard will be greatly appreciated.
